Perfect Pumpkin Pancakes



Ingredients:

- 2 cups flour
- 2 tablespoons brown sugar
- 1 tablespoon baking powder
- 1 1/4 teaspoons pumpkin pie spice
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 egg
- 1/2 cup canned pumpkin
- 1 3/4 cup milk, low-fat
- 2 tablespoons vegetable oil

Directions:

- 1. In a large mixing bowl, combine flour, brown sugar, baking powder, pumpkin pie spice and salt.
- 2. In a medium bowl, combine egg, canned pumpkin, milk, and vegetable oil, mixing well.
- 3. Add wet ingredients to flour mixture, stirring just until moist. Batter may be lumpy. For thinner batter, add more milk.
- 4. Lightly coat a griddle or skillet with cooking spray and heat to medium.

Drop batter mixture onto the prepared griddle by heaping tablespoon. Cook until golden brown, turning once with a spatula when the surface begins to bubble. Continue cooking until the other side is golden brown. Repeat process, making 12 pancakes.

Make it a Meal

Serve with apple slices, raw nuts and skim milk.






